Day 2: Mar 29, 2019 - Reykjavik Welcome Breakfast/City Tour/Northern Lights Excursion:

Welcome to Iceland: Early morning arrival in Reykjavik, the world's northernmost capital that is known for its creative soul and eye-popping design. meet & greet your Jet Vacations local hosts and transfer from Keflavik airport to a restaurant at a nearby village for your welcome breakfast. During breakfast, you'll receive an orientation briefing and get introduced to your group. Following breakfast, you'll head straight to the capital for your panoramic Reykjavik city tour and take in the city's major attractions. Highlights include the old town, the Parliament, the Cathedral, the harbor, the national museum, the Laugadalur swimming, the Asmundur Sveinsson Sculpture museum, the Pearl, the Hofi House, and the city's main landmark, the Hallgrímskirkja. Then, transfer to your centrally located hotel to check in and enjoy the afternoon / early evening at leisure. Later this evening, if the weather cooperates, embark on an included Northern Lights (or Aurora Borealis) excursion in search of the entrancing and magical display of beautiful colors dancing across the night sky. Please note that there is no guarantee that you will see the Northern Lights during your trip, but Jet Vacations will make every effort to help you experience it. If the forecast is suboptimal this evening, your Reykjavik Northern Lights excursion will be rescheduled for another evening. And don't forget, your overnight stay in the remote village of Vik in South Iceland is the best opportunity to see the Northern Lights at their best. Overnight at the Klettur Hotel (B)

Day 3: Mar 30, 2019 - Reykjavik City Tour – Reykjavik/ Optional Wonders of Snaefellsnes Excursion.

Wake up in Iceland's capital city and enjoy a buffet breakfast at your centrally-located hotel. You can enjoy a day at leisure for independent sightseeing in or around Reykjavik, or you can join a fascinating full day optional excursion where you'll discover the Snaefellsnes peninsula in the west of Island with its white and black sand beaches, bird cliffs, spectacular mountains, volcanic craters and charming fishing villages. The spectacular Snaefellsnes peninsula has captured the attention of people across the globe, as it was featured in the famous science fiction novel "Journey to the Center of the Earth" and in the critically acclaimed movie "The Secret Life of Walter Mitty" starring Ben Stiller. Day 4: Mar 31, 2019 - Reykjavik/Seljalandsfoss & Skogarfoss Waterfalls/Black Sand Beaches/Vik/Northern Lights Experience.

After breakfast, begin your journey through the stunning landscapes of Iceland's south coast. This is the land of Njal's Saga, a region of breathtaking scenery and legendary stories. During your guided excursion, you'll encounter the wonderful variety of the south: from the wide plains formed by glacial rivers to the dramatic sea cliffs of Dyrhólaey to the spectacular waterfalls of Seljalandsfoss and Skogarfoss. Along the way, you'll also savor unforgettable views of the Hekla and Eyjafjallajökull volcanoes and the beautiful village of Vik, Arrive at your countryside hotel, where you'll check in and then enjoy an included dinner at the hotel. Later this evening, simply leave your hotel room for an excellent opportunity to see the Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis) in this remote part of Iceland. Vik is considered to be one of the most magical places to take in a Northern Lights experience. Hotel Katla (B,D)

Day 5: April 01, 2019 - Vik/Geysir/Gulfoss/Thingvellir/Reykjavik.

Following breakfast this morning, depart for a journey through some of Iceland's most spectacular and noteworthy sights as you make your way back to Reykjavik. Your first highlight of the day is the hot spring area to see the famous Geysir and Strokkur, a magical shot spring that spouts every few minutes. Get your cameras ready for an exciting show! Onwards to Gulfoss (translated as "Golden Falls"), Iceland's most famous and impressive waterfall featuring a spectacular double cascade. Your next stop is Thingvellir National Park, where the ancient Viking parliament met for centuries on the shores of Iceland's largest lake. Here, you can also witness the geological phenomenon of tectonic plates coming apart. Later, return to your centrally-located hotel in Reykjavik and enjoy an evening at leisure. Center Hotel Plaza (B)

Day 6: April 02, 2019 - Reykjavik/Reykjanes Peninsula/Blue Lagoon/Farewell Dinner.

Today, you will combine a tour of the fascinating area beyond Reykjavik with a reviving visit to one of Iceland's most astonishing natural wonders. Your tour explores: Hafnarfjörður town, built on an ancient lava flow; the otherworldly surroundings of Lake Kleifarvatn; Krisuvik, a geothermal field; and the port town of Grindavik. You will also have the chance to explore Gunnhver geothermal area and Reykjanesviti light house. A visit to the Blue Lagoon will give you a warm and relaxing end of the day. The Blue Lagoon itself is a unique gift of nature, it's electric blue water set in a black lava field. You'll enjoy a reviving bathe in the mineral rich geothermal water before heading back to Reykjavik! This evening, enjoy a farewell dinner with your group where you'll celebrate your experience in incredible Iceland. (B,D)

Day 7: April 03, 2019 - Reykjavik/Harpa Concert Hall/USA.

A morning at leisure before checking out of your hotel. Before noon, your guide will lead you on a short walk to the Harpa Concert Hall, opened in 2011. The building is the first purpose-built concert hall in Reykjavik and houses the Iceland Symphony Orchestra and the offices of The Icelandic Opera. You will enjoy a guided tour before departing for the airport for your return flight home. (B)

April 03, 2019 - Arrive to Helsinki

Meet guide and coach at airport and transfer to hotel. In the afternoon, your local guide will take you on a 1-hour orientation walk around the hotel. Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Hotel Helsinki. (D)

Day 8: April 04, 2019 –City tour of Helsinki

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, enjoy a city sightseeing tour of Helsinki with local guide and coach. Along your tour you will be passing the biggest Orthodox cathedral in Northern Europe, the Uspenski Cathedral. Stop here for a visit inside with your guide. Afterwards stop for some photos in Senate Square with Helsinki Cathedral in the background. Take a walk to the local open-air market at Market Square. Drive down the city's main thoroughfare, Mannerheim Street, which passes Finlandia Hall, the National Museum, and the Parliament House. Admire the architecture of Kiasma, the Helsinki Museum of Contemporary Art, then continue to the Opera House and the stadium used for the 1952 Olympics. Disembark at Sibelius Park for some photos of the monument to composer Jean Sibelius, then continue to the famous church built into solid rock, the Temppeliaukio Church for an inside visit. Rest of the day is free at leisure. Overnight in Helsinki (B)

Day 9: April 05, 2019 - Free day on own OR join an optional tour to Porvoo

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy spending the day at leisure or join an optional tour to Porvoo. Set out to discover the delightful town of Porvoo on a private tour from Helsinki along with a local guide. Venture east to this medieval town, Finland's second oldest, and learn about its 14th-century origins and the people who shaped it as you explore. Take a walking tour through the cobbled Old Town, and admire the 15th-century cathedral, old Town Hall and traditional, red-painted storehouses along the riverside. Before returning to Helsinki, enjoy free time to stroll, relax and perhaps buy souvenirs at the quaint craft shops. Lunch will be included for you at a local restaurant. In the evening, transfer to your cabin for overnight the overnight sailing to Stockholm. Smogasbord dinner onboard. Overnight on the Ferry. (B, D)

Day 10: April 06, 2019 – Stockholm City Tour.

After breakfast onboard, set out on a Stockholm city tour. Stroll the cobblestone streets and learn about Birger Jarl, the man who founded the city of Stockholm in 1250. Walk through narrow passageways and streets built for horses, not cars, on your way to check out the Storkyrkan (Coronation Church). Admire the statue of St George and the Dragon that stands inside the brick Gothic cathedral. Make your way to Kungliga Slottet, or the Royal Palace, to see the stately architecture and palace guards that surround the place that Stockholm's Royal family calls home. We will go to Djurgården, a small island where the Vasa Museum stands. Take a half-hour tour that shows you the highlights of the ancient ship, sunk in the waters off Stockholm in 1628 during its maiden voyage. Explore the ship itself, watch a short film in the museum. Overnight in Stockholm. (B)

Day 11: April 07, 2019 – Departure day

Breakfast at your hotel. Transfer from the hotel to the airport with coach and guide. (B) End of your tour

Air arrangements: Fares and schedules are based on regular scheduled carrier service. All applicable airline rules apply and schedules are subject to change. Basic airfares include fuel surcharges, airport departure taxes, passenger facility charges (PFCs), customs or immigration fees, but do not include excess baggage charges and any other airline imposed charges. For mileage accrual information, please contact the carrier directly for details. Air inclusive group packages are non-changeable and non-refundable once deposit has been paid. Rules and fees for canceling and revising airfares vary depending upon the type of airfare purchased. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Lost paper tickets have no refund value.

IMPORTANT NOTE ON FUEL SURCHARGES: Fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines are valid at time of contract and are included in the price of your tour. As fuel continues to fluctuate, if the fuel surcharges change prior to your departure date, you will be assessed this additional amount.

Seat assignments: We block group seats with many major carriers, as well as chartered air carriers. We have absolutely no control over seat assignment. Specific seat requests are subject to availability at airport check-in only or passengers may contact the airlines for individual specific seating once tickets have been issued. Passenger "Record locators" are assigned by the airlines once the airlines has ticketed each passenger from the group block. This usually occurs between 60 to 30 days prior the departure date. After the airlines have assigned each traveler a "record locator", travelers may contact the airlines directly to discuss his or her seat preference. Airlines may impose additional fees for specific seats.

Cancellation Policies: No charges other than the non-refundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 180 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. However, services which have been prepaid by Jet Vacations LLC on behalf of individual clients maybe non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non changeable and/or maybe subject to a cancellation- change fee (e.g. theater tickets, Train tickets, Airline Tickets, Event Tickets, Passes, Entrance fees etc.).

Full cancellation: Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to immediately pay the outstanding balance. Payment shall then be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall be deemed to be canceled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its obligations, cancellation penalties shall be invoiced and calculated as follows:

Initial deposit** - non-refundable.

From 180 to 91 days prior departure: 35% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 90 to 61 days prior departure: 50% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 60 to 31 days prior departure: 75% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 30 to day of departure & no show: 100% penalty of the total cost per person.

** Deposit to hold the space and First deposit is non-refundable. If a passenger cancellation creates a change in the price schedule, the tour price will be revised based on the remaining number of participants. A passenger becoming a single as a result of a partner's cancellation must pay the single supplement.

NOTE: The following non-refundable fees will be added to the penalty charges listed on the cancellation (full or partial) schedule above: Travel protection premiums. On these occasions, we reserve the right to make such modifications and substitute conveyances/hotels as deemed necessary.

Minimum participants to Operate: Group needs a minimum of 20 participants to operate. Optional tours need a minimum of 15 participants to operate.

Tour Cancellation: We reserve the right to cancel the entire trip (or any component of the trip) for any reason and/or time. In this event, our liability, if any, shall be limited to and liquidated by refunding to each prospective participant the payments made.

Cruise line - Hotel selection: It is the responsibility of client to ensure that the cruise line - hotels and venues that are suggested and selected in this proposal are adequate for their clientele.
