

ITINERARY

DAY 1: AUGUST 30th - Departs the USA for Spain

Leave Sarasota (SRQ) on your overnight, connecting flight to Madrid, Spain.

DAY 2 AUGUST 31st - MADRID

Welcome to Madrid! Madrid is one of the world's most vibrant and seductive cities. A city that takes unabashed pleasure in its past traditions, it is proud to display a wealth of cultural treasures and architectural glories. It always manages to exceed expectations. Arriving in Madrid's Airport this morning, our representative will be waiting for you in the arrivals area to provide a private transfer to your hotel. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure with welcome dinner at the hotel. Overnight at your hotel. (D)

DAY 3 SEPTEMBER 1st - MADRID

Breakfast and accommodation at hotel. Morning guided city tour, we will visit the old part of the town called the Madrid of the Ausburg (Dynasty from XV to XVIIIth century), where Madrid became capital of a huge Empire. We will visit the charming corner of the downtown as Plaza Mayor, Plaza de la Villa, etc. We will visit inside the Royal Palace, rebuilt in XVIIIth century, where all important official ceremonies are still celebrated. Afternoon free at leisure. Optional afternoon Toledo Excursion. Overnight at your hotel. (B) *****

DAY 4 SEPTEMBER 2nd - MADRID-CORDOBA-TORREMOLINOS

Breakfast at hotel. Departure along the flat region of "La Mancha", the Don Quixote's scenario. Arrive Cordoba and lunch at local restaurant. Afterwards guide city tour of Cordoba - During the Roman age, this city was important, but during the Moslem domination it reached the maximum splendor, especially in the IX and Xth centuries, when Cordoba became the capital of the Caliphate, was the most populated town in the world (almost 1 million). Morning guided city tour, to visit the Mosque, considered one of the most beautiful. Then, a walk around the Jewish Quarter, with its narrow streets and Andalusia "patios", and finishing with a visit of the Synagogue. After the visit, we will continue to Torremolinos on the Costa del Sol. Overnight at your hotel. (B, L)

DAY 5 - SEPTEMBER 3rd - TORREMOLINOS - GRANADA

Day tour to Granada. Granada was an important Islamic kingdom in middle age but it reached its maximum splendor in XIVth century, when the city was the capital of the Islamic kingdom Nasrid, the last Islamic kingdom in the peninsula. It was a very sophisticated royal family, promoting the development of literature, art and science. In 1492 finally, it passes to the Crown of Castile, transforming the city. We will visit the Palace of Alhambra and Generalife gardens, the most beautiful medieval building of Arab art in the world. Located on a hill called Assabica (red), it dominates completely the city. Indescribable beauty of its courtyards and palaces, represent the splendor of the city in the middle age. The Gardens of Generalife, with its beautiful fountains, was a resting place for the Nazarid kings. We will enjoy a fresh and relaxing sound of the water in this lovely place. Lunch at local restaurant. We will follow to visit the Royal Chapel, the burial of Catholic King considered a masterpiece of the Renaissance art. (B, L)

DAY 6 SEPTEMBER 4th - TORREMOLINOS - OPTIONAL Gibraltar

Full day at leisure to enjoy the wonderful Costa Del Sol or take an optional tour to Gibraltar (remember to bring your passport as you will be traveling to the UK!)

Gibraltar is a British Overseas Territory and headland, on Spain's south coast. It's dominated by the Rock of Gibraltar, a 426m-high limestone ridge. First settled by the Moors in the Middle Ages and later ruled by Spain, the outpost was ceded to the British in 1713. Layers of fortifications include the remains of a Moorish Castle and the 18th century Great Siege Tunnels, which were expanded in WWII. Lunch included.

DAY 7 SEPTEMBER 5th - TORREMOLINOS - MALAGA

Breakfast. Day Tour Malaga. Described by Vicente Aleixandre as the City of Paradise, Malaga enjoys one of the best climates in the European continent. The visitor can stroll in the gardens and enjoy the view of the city, the port and the distant mountain ranges. We will pass through the most emblematic corners of the city, such as Larios street, Pasaje de Chinitas, Plaza de la Merced (where Picasso was born), the Town hall, the Bullring and the park, the Cathedral or Catedral de la Encarnación, a Renaissance church located within the limits defined by a now missing portion of the medieval Moorish walls, the remains of which surround the nearby The Alcazaba (Muslim castle), a palatial fortification. It was built by the Hammudid dynasty in the early 11th century. It was constructed between 1528 and 1782, following the plans drawn by Diego de Siloe. Lunch at local restaurant included. Overnight at your hotel. (B, L)

DAY 8 SEPTEMBER 6th - TORREMOLINOS - RHONDA- SEVILLE

Ronda is one of the most ancient cities in Spain, centre of the mountain range which bears its name. An impressive sheer cleft of over 300 ft. called El Tajo splits the town, dividing the old part from the new one. We will visit the Church of Santa Maria, formerly the Mosque, with Gothic and Renaissance architecture, Plateresque altarpiece and choir stalls and Hispano-Moslem tower. Then we will do a tour of the old town, rich in places of interest, palaces and convents. Our tour will end with a visit of the bullring, built in 1784, totally of stone, which is considered to be the oldest in Spain, and where Pedro Romero, the famous bullfighter, set up the rules of bullfighting on foot which are nowadays still respected. Enjoy lunch on your own.

Seville. Inhabited during more than 25 centuries: Tartesso (pre Roman culture), Romans, Visigoths, ... but with the Islamic period it becomes after XIIIth century capital of a powerful Islamic kingdom. It was recovered in 1248 by Christians, Fernando III the Saint developed intensively the city. With the discovery of America, it becomes the port and location of all institutions that control all trade with America. The maximum splendor of the city will be in XVI and XVIIth. Today is the beautiful capital of Andalusia, famous for the liveliness of its celebrations, the grandeur of its processions, flower-filled balconies and patios. (B)

DAY 9 SEPTEMBER 7th - SEVILLE

Breakfast. This morning we will have a guided city tour of Sevilla, visiting the gothic Cathedral, the third largest in the world, and where is the tomb of Christopher Columbus. The bell tower, called La Giralda (was once the minaret of the mosque), now a symbol of the city, it offers a spectacular view of the city. Then, a walk in the Quarter of Santa Cruz, a colorful maze of alleys, small squares and nice gardens, which is an invitation to rest. Also, you will visit the Maria Luisa Park where it is located the monumental Plaza de España. Breakfast at hotel. Departure to on private transfer Seville through Ronda.

Arrive to Hotel. Accommodation

In the evening round trip transfer to Flamenco farewell dinner. Overnight at your hotel. (B, D).

DAY 10 SEPTEMBER 8th - SEVILLE

Breakfast at Hotel. After checking out, transfer to the airport, where you will board your flight home. (B)

DAY 10 SEPTEMBER 8th - SEVILLE-BADAJOS

After breakfast departure to Badajoz. Badajoz is the capital of the Province of Badajoz in the autonomous community of Extremadura, Spain. It is situated close to the Portuguese border. Conquered by the Moors in the 8th century, Badajoz became a Moorish kingdom, the Taifa of Badajoz. After the reconquista, the area was disputed between Spain and Portugal for several centuries with alternating control. The city has a degree of eminence, crowned as it is by the ruins of a Moorish castle and overlooking the Guadiana river, which flows between the castle-hill and the powerfully armed fort of San Cristobal. The architecture of Badajoz is indicative of its tempestuous history; even the Badajoz Cathedral, built in 1238, resembles a fortress, with its massive walls. Accommodation at Hotel. (B, D)

DAY 11 SEPTEMBER 9th - BADAJOZ-BARCARROTA-BADAJOZ

After breakfast departure to Barcarrota to attend activities organized by the Greater Manatee Chamber and Sister city, Barcarrota. Return to Badajoz for overnight. (B)

DAY 12 SEPTEMBER 10th - BADAJOZ-EVORA-LISBON

Breakfast at hotel. Our representative will be waiting at hotel to transfer you to Lisbon via Evora. Arrival to Evora one of Portugal's most beautifully preserved medieval towns, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Your guide reveals how Evora's Roman ruins, Moorish arcades, and a score of churches and monasteries create a fascinating cultural tapestry; see the Capela dos Ossos, the 15th century Church of Sao Francisco, and the Cathedral of St. Mary. Spend the remainder exploring this enchanting town at your own pace, and discover its labyrinthine streets, picturesque town squares, and a great display of Moorish-inspired arches. After visit lunch at local restaurant. Then continuous to Lisbon. Arrive Lisbon and accommodation at Hotel. (B, L)

DAY 13 SEPTEMBER 11th - LISBON

After breakfast at your hotel, enjoy a morning tour of Lisbon, including the opportunity to explore the city center, the old quarter of Alfama, as well as the Belem quarter and its monuments including Jeronimos Monastery, the Belem Tower, and the Monument to the Discoveries. This city, the capital of Portugal, is a legendary city with more than 20 centuries of history. Voyages of discovery turned Lisbon into one of the world's greatest ports and the base of an empire that stretched from Brazil in the West to India in the East. This monumental city features typical tile covered building facades and narrow winding streets. Tonight your welcome to Portugal features a flavorful dinner of local favorites and an unforgettable Fado show. Meaning "destiny" or "fate", Fado is the urban folk music of Portugal. It thrives today in the country's bars, taverns and Fado houses for everyone to relish as a global melodic symbol of Portuguese culture and tradition. Sit back and feel free to linger over some portwine and take in the soulful passion of Portugal via its musical tradition of Fado that is sure to stir the passion in you! Dinner at Fado Restaurant. Accommodation at Hotel.

DAY 14 SEPTEMBER 12th - LISBON

Breakfast at Hotel. Private transfer to Lisbon airport and end of services.

Air arrangements: Fares and schedules are based on regular scheduled carrier service. All applicable airline rules apply and schedules are subject to change. Basic airfares include fuel surcharges, airport departure taxes, passenger facility charges (PFCs), customs or immigration fees, but do not include excess baggage charges and any other airline-imposed charges. For mileage accrual information, please contact the carrier directly for details. Air inclusive group packages are non-changeable and non-refundable once deposit has been paid. Rules and fees for canceling and revising airfares vary depending upon the type of airfare purchased. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Lost paper tickets have no refund value.

IMPORTANT NOTE ON FUEL SURCHARGES: Fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines are valid at time of contract and are included in the price of your tour. As fuel continues to fluctuate, if the fuel surcharges change prior to your departure date, you will be assessed this additional amount.

Seat assignments: We block group seats with many major carriers, as well as chartered air carriers. We have absolutely no control over seat assignment. Specific seat requests are subject to availability at airport check-in only or passengers may contact the airlines for individual specific seating once tickets have been issued. Passenger "Record locators" are assigned by the airlines once the airlines has ticketed each passenger from the group block. This usually occurs between 60 to 30 days prior the departure date. After the airlines have assigned each traveler a "record locator", travelers may contact the airlines directly to discuss his or her seat preference. Airlines may impose additional fees for specific seats.

Cancellation Policies: No charges other than the non-refundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 180 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. However, services which have been prepaid by Jet Vacations LLC on behalf of individual clients maybe non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non-changeable and/or may be subject to a cancellation- change fee (e.g. theater tickets, Train tickets, Airline Tickets, Event Tickets, Passes, Entrance fees etc.).

Full cancellation: Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to immediately pay the outstanding balance. Payment shall then be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall

be deemed to be canceled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its obligations, cancellation penalties shall be invoiced and calculated as follows:
 Initial deposit**: non-refundable.
 From 180 to 91 days prior departure: 35% penalty of the total cost per person.
 From 90 to 61 days prior departure: 50% penalty of the total cost per person.
 From 60 to 31 days prior departure: 75% penalty of the total cost per person.
 From 30 to day of departure & no show: 100% penalty of the total cost per person.
 ** Deposit to hold the space and First deposit is non-refundable. If a passenger cancellation creates a change in the price schedule, the tour price will be revised based on the remaining number of participants. A passenger becoming a single as a result of a partner's cancellation must pay the single supplement.

NOTE: The following non-refundable fees will be added to the penalty charges listed on the cancellation (full or partial) schedule above: Travel protection premiums. Travel protection plan: The Travel Protection Plan may not be purchased after final payment has been made. Insurance premium has to be purchased within 5 days of booking. You understand that the travel insurance is provided by a third party and that all claims will have to be addressed directly with the Travel Insurance Provider.

Itinerary variation: We will make every effort to operate all tours as advertised. Situations may arise, voluntarily or involuntarily, that require changes or exceptions in the airport of departure, the itinerary, land arrangements, hotels, trains or ports of call. On these occasions, we reserve the right to make such modifications and substitute conveyances/hotels as deemed necessary.

Minimum participants to Operate: Group needs a minimum of 20 participants to operate. Optional tours need a minimum of 15 participants to operate.

Tour Cancellation: We reserve the right to cancel the entire trip (or any component of the trip) for any reason and/or time. In this event, our liability, if any, shall be limited deposit) by refunding to each prospective participant the payments made.

Cruise line - Hotel selection: It is the responsibility of client to ensure that the cruise line - hotels and venues that are suggested and selected in this proposal are adequate for their clientele.
