

# **Strengthening Our Community through Connectedness - Palmetto Trails Network Project**



Imagine a re-activated historic Lincoln Memorial High School tunnel connects Lincoln Park with Lincoln Memorial Academy.

Successful and thriving communities don't just happen anywhere. They develop in places with engaged individuals, strong leaders, and top decision makers who are responsive to the area's needs. It takes intentional public policy to help design our community and enhance our quality of life. The Palmetto Trails Network Project (PTNP) exemplifies this idea. The proposed project responds to critical needs that will enhance our quality of life and strengthen our community.

The PTNP is a collaborative effort between Manatee County, the City of Palmetto, the Florida Department of Transportation, and the Sarasota-Manatee Metropolitan Organization to create a system of high quality, multi modal trails and facilities designed to reestablish connections previously lost in a time-worn and economically distressed community. With full support of our Board of Directors, the Manatee Chamber submitted a letter to the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Transportation urging the department to approve BUILD grant funding to complete this project.

During the 1950's, historic neighborhoods were divided while constructing US 41 in the City of Palmetto. This roadway construction split apart an established community, dividing neighborhoods from schools, economic centers from consumers and workers, and created unsafe pedestrian mobility. The historic tunnel that previously connected Lincoln Memorial High (Lincoln Memorial Academy) and Lincoln Park has long been closed off, thus requiring local residents and students to cross at an unsafe intersection.

The PTNP will provide improved access and mobility to three public schools, over a dozen neighborhoods, five parks, a public transit transfer station, conference centers, and employment centers located along the trail alignments. The project will include numerous pedestrian safety enhancements, including intersection improvements and lighting. The trail connections established by this project will integrate with the established regional SUN Trail alignment for continuous bicycle connections from outside Palmetto and across the Manatee River.

Our community will also benefit by project elements that create a healthier, cleaner natural environment, including:

- Improved storm water attenuation
- Reduced pollution, sediment, and other runoff reaching the mangroves and water systems
- Long-term brownfield redevelopment expected over the next 5-15 years
- Reduced heat-island impacts within the City of Palmetto through shade trees and landscaping along the project network

We want our region to continue to be viewed as a top destination for residents and visitors, and among the best nationwide in well-being. Projects like the PTNP will continue our effort to create strong, healthy communities with safe, multi modal options while strengthening our local economy and business environment.


# Manatee Memorial Hospital Is Keeping Pace with Our Growing Community

Manatee Memorial Hospital is committed to providing the citizens of Manatee County with advanced healthcare services.

In keeping with this priority, construction of a new Emergency Care Center (ECC) on the hospital's main campus began last year. Project completion is expected in late 2018.

At 37,000 square feet, the new ECC will almost double the size of the existing Emergency Room. There will be a dedicated Emergency Medical Services (EMS) covered drive access with three staging and support areas for emergency vehicles. A canopy will cover the emergency public drop off/entry.

Other features of the new building will include 48 treatment spaces, organized in four clinical care areas, housing 24 universal exam rooms, 8 fast track rooms, and 16 super track rooms, which are functionally able to flex as needed based on demand.



- Three behavioral health rooms
- Two resuscitation rooms
- · One bariatric room with integral patient lift
- One gynecology room
- Two negative pressure/contact isolation rooms (one of which is designed to facilitate a high containment patient).

Our ECC personnel will have convenient access to:

- Imaging
- Surgery
- Cardiac catheterization labs
- Intensive Care Unit
- Medical/Surgical units

Manatee Memorial Hospital, a member of the Manatee Healthcare System and a proud Platinum Member of the Manatee Chamber of Commerce, has served the residents of Manatee County for 65 years.






