

Mini-City - Police, Fire, Public Works, Administration












### **AUTHORITY FINANCES**

- → Only taxes received are from airline tickets and aviation fuel.

### **AUTHORITY FINANCES**

- → \$47 Million in Cash & Investments.
- → \$250 Million in Fixed Assets.
- → NO DEBT. Last payment made August 2014. Few airports in U.S. debt free.
- → Signatory Airline Agreements through 2024 with DL, AA, JB, UA, WN, G9.
- → Airport Has Net Surplus each year.
- → Airport operations are totally self sufficient.





### **FUEL FARM EXPANSION**

- → (2) 100,000-gallon fuel tanks. Total capacity is now 290,000 gallons.
- → A new administration building/office space for fuel farm staff is under construction.






**Completed - Operational: July 2021**

## **PARKING LOT EXPANSION**

- → Add 135 parking spaces to the south end of the long-term parking lot
- → Add 204 paved parking spaces to the grass overflow lot adjacent to the shade parking lot



### **WAYFINDING SIGNAGE PROJECT**


→ - Replace and optimize all airport wayfinding signage.

### **BLAST FENCE**

- → Extend Existing Blast Fence to Protect Employee Lot and Ground Transportation
- → Allow better utilization of gate B2. Larger Aircraft can use the gate without the risk of jet blast causing adverse affects to vehicles and persons in the employee lot and ground transportation area.





## **ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEM REPLACEMENT**

- → Complete Access Control System upgrade, with new cabling, hardware, software, servers and workstations.
- → All airfield gate motors replaced. Added 2 existing gates to access control.





## AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE HANGAR / A&P SCHOOL

→ - Site work underway for a new Aircraft Maintenance Hangar and A&P Mechanic School.


# PROJECTS IN DESIGN PROCESS

## ANTICIPATED NEEDS



### **GROUND TRANSPORTATION CENTER**


→ - Create a larger taxi/limo staging area, Uber/Lyft staging area and a waiting area for other vehicles that reduces congestion and interference with curbside passenger pick-ups



## **U.S. CUSTOMS - GENERAL AVIATION**

→ - Planning is underway to construct a stand-alone U.S. Customs Clearance facility for General Aviation Aircraft.

This will free up Gate B8 for exclusive air carrier use.





## **CONSOLIDATED RENTAL CAR FACILITY**


→ - Streamline rental car service and staging and open property along Rental Car Road for development.



## **TERMINAL BUILDOUT**


→ - Build out additional space on the Concourse to increase capacity and accommodate more concessions






## **GROUND BOARDING TERMINAL**


## **TERMINAL- Level 2- Phase 2**





### **CONSOLIDATED BAGGAGE SYSTEM**

→ - Re-design the baggage belt system to connect all ticket counter positions with a central baggage screening room. After screening, baggage will be distributed to one of four baggage carousels.



## 15<sup>TH</sup> STREET OBSERVATION AREA

→ - Build observation area shelter, paved parking, and informational signage along 15<sup>th</sup> street.



## RAMP OVERFLOW / REMOTE BOARDING

→ - Acquisition of an ADA-compliant aircraft boarding ramp for use at existing/future remote parking locations.



### WHAT CAN YOU DO?

### **Check SRQ First and Always**

- → Look at cost of travel from your door and back.
- → Cost of fuel to more distant airports, higher parking charges and your time.
- → Connecting flights should not deter you.
- → You must leave at least 1-2 hours earlier to go to more distant airport.
- → Higher probability of vehicle incidents delaying your travel than aircraft issue.
- → Airline has no responsibility if you miss the flight due to ground traffic.
- → Airlines know your behavior. You reinforce airline's decision not to serve your community.
